Build Eco-Office Model Branch Office -- Commence trial in Kobe Chuo Building, Hyogo Branch (Dec.) --

In addition to reducing power consumption by using LED lighting and through making power consumption visible, deploy thin client terminals on the applicable floors and use "hot desking"^{*} to revolutionize work styles (greater flexibility in work areas)

Details of Efforts:

- 50% reduction in power usage (lighting, PCs)
- Energy saving by introducing LED lighting, motion detectors, brightness sensors and thin client terminals
- With flexible work areas, save energy with lights and air conditioning
- · Reduction of number of printers and copiers in offices

Making energy consumption visible

- Conduct energy consumption analysis by area unit (identify the heaviness of the use)
- Raise employee awareness of environmental efforts

Reduce amount of office paper use

- Paperless meetings, etc., to reduce paper use
- Reduction of office waste
- Use recycled-material products and recyclable products
